

2020 Classics Cruisin' Table Rock Lake . . . some points of interest . . .

WATERWAYS:

TABLE ROCK LAKE - is a manmade lake in southwestern Missouri and northern Arkansas held back by a 252' deep dam on the White River. Because it travels through the heart of the Ozarks including the Mark Twain National Forest, it is enclosed by miles of beautiful natural bluffs and vegetation. At pool level, the lake's surface covers 43,100 acres and 745 miles of shoreline.



ACCOMMODATIONS: [ROCK LANE RESORT](#) - Home Port for the event (417) 338-2211

Situated on Indian Point Peninsula on Table Rock Lake, this resort and marina is 3.2 miles from Silver Dollar City and 7 miles from Branson's Entertainment Strip. Modest rooms feature free Wifi, cable TV and DVD players. All include mini-fridges, microwaves and coffeemakers. Because we are into summer tourists' season, these rooms normally go for \$119/night but are offered to us at \$60/night.

Rock Lane will even extend this rate for you if you add nights before or after the Cruisin' event.

Their Marina offers **covered slips** for nightly rental, plus full-service gas pumps with non-ethanol fuel. **Overnight slips are limited - get your reservation ASAP.** (417) 338-4433

STOPS ALONG THE WAY: (somehow always eating, this event has been labeled a 7 pound affair)

Rock Island Grill - the **Welcome Dinner** on Thursday evening at Rock Lane is here. We suggest that you also enjoy what this on-site "bar and grill" has to offer at other times during your stay. **Rock Island Grill** is part of the Rock Lane Resort.

Campbell Point Marina and Watson's on the Water restaurant - (**Thursday's optional day trip.**) Table Rock Lake's main channel follows the White River Valley which we'll follow west about 30 miles. Campbell Point Marina has an exciting gift shop, and Watson's is one of the favorite stops on the lake for lunch.

Floating Café - This fun café is located on the west side of the same peninsula as Rock Lane. There are new boat slips for our beautiful boats. The café will be reserved for our group for **Friday morning's Brunch**, price included in registration. That's right - BRUNCH. Classics Cruisin' has been accused in the past of over-feeding the fleet. The café's brunch will suffice as more than enough for this combined breakfast and lunch. You'll be set for the day.

Parrots Pavilion - serves great food and drinks with a relaxed atmosphere and live entertainment as a Friday night option. This is the outdoor/covered bar and eatery right at Rock Lane Resort.

Branson Shows - available in close-by Branson for a Friday evening option. There will be time to include an evening "in town" if you wish. See show times and make your own arrangements at websites such as <https://www.bransonshows.com/showByDate.cfm>

Big Cedar Lodge - boat in and dock at Big Cedar's Marina, shuttle up to the Devil's Pool/Buzzard Bar. There's always something new to explore at Big Cedar.

Chateau on the Lake - It's just a few minutes' boat ride to the Chateau's boat slips. Then a shuttle will deliver us to the Chateau's four-star facilities. The complete **Saturday breakfast buffet** is included in your registration. The food is excellent, the service is excellent, the view inside and out is excellent. What a perfect way to start off the Classics Cruisin' Show Day.

Ozarks Yacht Club - You're in the Ozarks, so do **NOT** get too gussied up. This is the perfect, very casual, **Saturday evening** place to socialize, have a quiet conversation and listen to each other's boat stories. It's just about 2 miles by car. **Flat Creek Grill** (most popular restaurant of locals in the Ozarks) will be catering a Broasted Chicken Dinner with large servings of potatoes, green beans, slaw, biscuit & honey - just like goin' to Grandma's for family dinner. This evening's cost is included in registration fee.
